Church members always have priority for their first award or a second year award IF their application is similar in quality to the other applicants and includes all required information. No students, member or non member, will be given an award for a third year.

CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

We had a wonderful time in July during our mini-VBS each Sunday School hour. We had anywhere from 11-14 kids each week. It was great to get to know the kids, for them to spend time together, and to learn a bit from the parables of Jesus!

We will have Rally Day on Sunday, September 14th. This day will be the start of the Sunday School year and will be the blessing of the backpacks. Please have children bring their backpacks to church with them that day for us to bless them for the school year!

We are aiming to have Sunday School every week and we will provide two classes (2-6years, 7years & up). We have purchased a curriculum called the **Year Long Bible Journey**.

In order to have a successful children's program, we need some classroom teachers & classroom volunteers!

We would like to have two assigned teachers for each age group for the year (four teachers total) so that children can get to know the teachers and so the teachers can rotate. The curriculum will be provided. Each teacher will need to do a background check (the church pays, they are required every 2 years). We are also in need of two additional volunteers each Sunday, one each to be in the classrooms as an additional adult so that two adults are present at all times. We are looking for eight volunteers total. Having eight will allow volunteers to be assigned just one Sunday/month.
